The SDABJ and National University are now offering a promising chance to a promising student. Gaining its start in 2004, the scholarship now offers either a four-year bachelors or masters degree education at National University's School of Media and Communications.

The requirements for this scholarship include:

- An essay discussing any experience you may have had in journalism
- A biographical sketch detailing who you are and why you deserve the scholarship
- A 300-word essay that discusses how you plan to bridge the gap between the African-
- American community and the media.
- Application form

The recipient of this scholarship may be someone who already is has a degree and job in another field or someone who may not have attended an institution of higher learning. The deadline for this application is **March 26, 2010**. Winners will be notified no later than **April 9**.

The checklist is as follows:

- 1. **Application Form** Complete and sign the attached application forms. All sections must be completed. If a block or section does not apply write "N/A".
- 2. **Transcript** Attach a copy of a college transcript. The transcript should be current as of your previous semester. If you did not attend college, we need a copy of your high school transcript.

3. Biographical Sketch – Prepare and sign a brief biographical sketch of yourself that explains your reason for requesting financial assistance. It must be double-spaced and must not exceed 200 words.

4. Essay – Prepare and sign a brief essay that discusses how you plan to bridge the gap between the African- American community and the media. It should be double-spaced and must not exceed 300 words.

5. Work Examples (optional) – Students may send examples of their work with high school newspapers and or TV programs. The work will **not** be returned.

6. Two letters of recommendation – It can be from a boss, colleague, pastor or other detailing why they think you deserve to be considered.
